As you all were informed in my previous letter (February), our students learned the months of the year and the days of the week. However on the last week of February a new unit on Farm Animals was introduced. This will be the unit for the month of March. The first two weeks (one from February) the children will learn the names of the animals. We will be focusing on the most common ones, probably ten animals. The remaining weeks of March we will cover some of the foods these animals produce. Then a quiz will wrap up the unit.

Homework

The students were given handouts on the names of the animals (ten of them). The children are supposed to color a barn and learn the names of the animals. Most of the time the students are given these handouts twice because either they lose their homework or forget it. Very specific directions are given in class on what to do with the assignments that go home. I go over the instructions as many times as possible for the children to understand the assignment.

After spring break the homework will be a handout, which will include the names of the foods the farm animals produce (the ten farm animals). Further instructions will be given in class.
